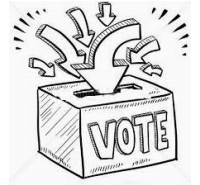
Active Kids

Vacancy



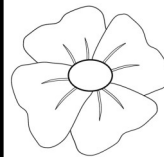
